We are so extremely grateful for the most generous donation of £1,000 to the Family of Hope.

We now have several older girls in the school, all of whom have special needs, and it is our intention to give them some of the life skills they will need as they approach adulthood. Your generous grant has enabled us to buy three sewing machines and employ local ladies to teach these young women how to make clothes and other items to sell.

We have also been able to send two of the girls and a member of staff on a "Day for Girls" course (as per the article in the Winter edition of "Magnet"). This will enable the girls to make sanitary protection for themselves, the other girls at school and to sell the surplus to the local community in our small shop on site. It is our hope that the school will eventually become self sufficient through the life skills programme now being developed.
